Knitted Together for God's Good Work through Our Finances

While 2020 was an unprecedented year, you ladies came through! I want to recap what the Harpeth River District UMW did financially.



In a year where meetings, mission studies & fundraisers had to be cancelled, we all worked together to fulfill our pledges as best we could. The Harpeth River District Pledge to Missions to the TN Conference for 2020 was \$25,000. Our total Pledge to Mission giving was \$22,265.75. That is 89% of our pledge. That is wonderful!

In addition, a total of \$1,363.00 was given to Beersheba Springs, Red Bird Mission, UMCOR, Bethlehem Center and the Sadie Tillman Scholarship at Martin Methodist. \$300.00 was sent to the Legacy Fund.

We had 8 units that filled out a Five-Star Giving Report. They will be recognized for their contributions to all Five Channels of Undesignated Giving. The units are listed below and will receive a Certificate of Recognition at the 2021 District Annual Meeting in September.
